A Zoning By-law amendment application (*Application/File: D19 5485WA*) has been submitted for a vacant 0.77 hectare (1.9 acre) parcel of land located north-west of the Walker Road and McCord Lane intersection (5485 Walker Road) (see Key Map on reverse side for location). The purpose of the proposed amendment is to rezone the property from “Hamlet Commercial Zone (CH)” to a site-specific “Hamlet Commercial (CH-6)” to permit the sale and service of motorcycles and other powersport vehicles such as ATVs, jet skis and dirt bikes. The subject property is designated “General Commercial” in the Official Plan.
